With try-outs and team selections just a short time away, we would like to call your attention to some very important financial information for our basketball program here at North Cobb.

We are sharing an upcoming financial commitment with you so that you will have advance notice prior to our annual "Tip-Off" meeting in November. At that meeting, each player's family will be expected to participate financially with a fee of \$250.00. Details of how your contribution will be utilized, are listed below.

North Cobb High School administration along with the Cobb County School System, are responsible for providing safe and useable space for athletes to compete. This basic contribution, which is standard across the County, is primarily the extent of their support for our basketball program. All other features and benefits of the program, including supporting the 3 girl's and 3 boy's teams, is made possible by funds raised and administered by our Booster Club.

Please take a few moments to familiarize yourself with the important information listed below. We wish your player participant good luck during try-outs and we look forward to the start of a new season at our "Tip-Off" meeting in November.

The North Cobb Warrior Basketball Booster Club would like to welcome you and thank you in advance for your support during the 2007-2008 Warrior Basketball season. We are looking forward to another exciting season of Warrior Basketball and we are pleased to have head coaches Terry Gorsuch and Matt Williams leading our program.

Participation on a high school athletic team is a privilege and a great experience for a student-athlete, and we are proud of all of our players and coaches. Our primary goal as a booster club is:

To support the players, the coaching staff, and the school administration at North Cobb in having a successful basketball program along with the pursuit of excellence in all of the athletic and academic endeavors of our players.

Parental support is our key in doing this, and Basketball Booster Club members contribute to the support of the basketball organization here at North Cobb High School by providing:

- * Player game uniforms (home and away)
- * Player gear package - player gets to keep these items (t-shirt, basketball shoes and warm-up)!
- * Basketballs, scorebooks, A/V equipment, etc.
- * Gym floor maintenance
- * Coaches gear, membership fees to the Georgia High School Coaches' Association, and clinic fees
- * Tournament fees and expenses
- * Varsity travel expenses
- * Year-End Banquet and Awards for players and coaches - others are required to pay.
- * College style locker rooms
- * Concession stand equipment

To provide this support, each family is expected to pay a total fee of \$250 per player which is due at our first Tip-Off meeting!

Again, parental support is our key to a successful season. The basketball fees will provide the equipment and services as listed above that are NOT provided by the school or the county. It is with that in mind that we ask for your help and participation in the various committees and activities that provide the backbone of this organization. There are never enough volunteers and numerous opportunities exist for you to participate at whatever level you can contribute.

Along with the financial commitment each family will be required to work in the concession at least 5 different scheduled times - never while your child is playing - you will be able to sign up for the work slots during our first mandatory meeting
